Experience of the pandemic caused by Corona Virus and the response for the physical mode of classes

Hoping against and dreaming of vanishing Pandemic Covid 19 and lockdowns new academic session 2021 -22 began on 12th April 2021. But the physical classes lasted only for 3 days after which due to second wave of pandemic lockdown declared in the state. From 19th April we had online regular classes with proper online time table. We also had 6 months off line classes observing the strict Covid 19 protocols as instructed by the state authorities.

It was a unique teaching learning process for the students and the teachers. Everyone co operated and worked hand in hand to update ourselves to the new situations and Computer assisted teaching learning on line.

Consequences:

- Drastic fall in the new admissions
- Financial difficulties to pay the school fees .
- Some students were not able to get online classes due poor mobile net work
- Teaching was not so effective like the physical classes
- Students became mobile addicted than studies.
- Parents involvement is more than the students on online classes.
- Standard of the studies have declined.
